#### "Choose wise and respected people." Deuteronomy 1:13

I heard someone say a few days ago that they weren't going to vote, they would just pray and God would provide. Um... no. That's not what God would want! In Deuteronomy 1:13 the Bible tells us we need to choose some wise, understanding, and respected people, and He will set them over us. Clearly God wants us to vote!

If you would like a good outline for how we should relate to government, politics and our civic duty, I recommend Romans 13.
