## "Season of Waiting"

I started my day with coffee and a discussion. We talked about what we think of when we talk about Advent. Some said - the story of the coming Jesus. Others said something about family and preparing to gather. Still others talked about being grateful for all we have, even though maybe we can't do the things we used to do.

The Bible passages in Advent help us remember that this is a season of waiting. Jeremiah 33:14-16 is one of the lectionary Old Testament scriptures I read this morning, and he tells us "the days are coming." The gospel of Luke 21:26-36 is a warning. It tells us we must "Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man."

I told the group at coffee that it might not seem like Christmas is coming when we're talking about warnings. But, it is true that if we are not thinking just about the coming of Christ, but potentially the coming of the Kingdom, maybe we need to heed the warning. Be always on the watch and avoid being "weighed down with carousing, drunkenness and the anxieties of life" (as Luke tells us - 21:34).

Let us remember to take time to enjoy every day. And, let us carry the joy through each moment of the day. Let us gather our family as close as we can. Let us be grateful for all our blessings. And, may we be watchful - may we anticipate the coming of the newborn King!






