Now it's up to us to plan and do the things that work toward and eventually accomplish that vision. It's a good lesson for all aspects of our lives, right?


VISIONING STATEMENT: **"The Spearfish United Church of Christ Congregational envisions a growing, thriving congregation of all ages."**
